## Qalhat LNG Signs Pact with Ministry of Manpower to Finance “Training for Development” Programs

Qalhat LNG signed an agreement with Ministry of Manpower for the financing and training of a number of Omani citizens as part of the Ministry’s “training for employment program” in the Ministry promises yesterday.



The agreement was signed by Sheikh Abdullah bin Nasser Al Bakri, Minister of Manpower, and Harib bin Abdullah Al Kitani, Qalhat LNG General Manager and CEO.

Hamed bin Khamis Al A’amri, Undersecretary for technical education and vocational training at the Ministry of Manpower, said the agreement worth RO 150,000 covered training

of 55 citizens in the fields of medical editor, driving heavy vehicles and draftsmen.

In a statement to mediaperson, Al A’amri said after completion of the training, the trainees would be sent to various private sector companies as per the needs of contracts of each company. The trainees have to go by the contracts with the companies.

The signing of the agreement comes within the existing cooperation and partnership between the government and the private sectors and the Ministry’s keenness to benefit from potentials available at the private sector’s potentials available at the private sector’s installations to train citizens as per the needs of the labour market.

He described the Qalhat LNG initiative as good, which reflected the company’s awareness for the importance of developing human resources.

The agreement signing ceremony was attended by a number of directors-general and officials at the Ministry of Manpower and a number of Qalhat LNG board’s members and employees.
